### **Psalm 42:11**

Why are you downcast, O my soul? Why so disturbed within me? Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise Him, my Savior and my God.

### **Isaiah 46:3-4**

"Listen to Me, O house of Jacob, all you who remain of the house of Israel, you whom I have upheld since you were conceived, and have carried since your birth. <sup>4</sup>Even to your old age and gray hairs I am He, I am He who will sustain you. I have made you and I will carry you; I will sustain you and I will rescue you.

### **Philippians 1:21**

For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.

### **Jeremiah 29:11-14**

"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. <sup>12</sup>Then you will call upon Me and come and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. <sup>13</sup>You will seek Me and find Me when you seek Me with all your heart. <sup>14</sup>I will be found by you," declares the LORD, "and will bring you back from captivity. I will gather you from all the nations and places where I have banished you," declares the LORD, "and will bring you back to the place from which I carried you into exile."

### **Proverbs 22:1**

A good name is more desirable than great riches; to be esteemed is better than silver or gold.

### **Psalm 30:4-5**

Sing to the LORD, you saints of His; praise His holy name. <sup>5</sup>For His anger lasts only a moment, but His favor lasts a lifetime; weeping may remain for a night, but rejoicing comes in the morning.

### **Acts 20:35**

In everything I did, I showed you that by this kind of hard work we must help the weak, remembering the words the Lord Jesus Himself said: "It is more blessed to give than to receive."

### **Matthew 5:3-6**

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. <sup>4</sup>Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted. <sup>5</sup>Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth. <sup>6</sup>Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled."

### **Matthew 5:7-10**

"Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy. <sup>8</sup>Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God. <sup>9</sup>Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God. <sup>10</sup>Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."

### **Matthew 5:11-12**

"Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of Me. <sup>12</sup>Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you."

### **1 Corinthians 13:4-7**

Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. <sup>5</sup>It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. <sup>6</sup>Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. <sup>7</sup>It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.

**Psalm 32:8**

“I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you and watch over you.”

**Proverbs 31:30**

Charm is deceptive, and beauty is fleeting; but a woman who fears the LORD is to be praised.

**Matthew 6:19-21**

“Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. <sup>20</sup>But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. <sup>21</sup>For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

**1 Corinthians 10:31**

So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.

**Romans 5:18-19**

Consequently, just as the result of one trespass was condemnation for all men, so also the result of one act of righteousness was justification that brings life for all men. <sup>19</sup>For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous.

**John 5:39-40**

“You diligently study the Scriptures because you think that by them you possess eternal life. These are the Scriptures that testify about Me, <sup>40</sup>yet you refuse to come to Me to have life.”

**1 Peter 2:9-10**

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His wonderful light. <sup>10</sup>Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

**Romans 10:17**

Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ.

**Matthew 20:26-28**

Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, <sup>27</sup>and whoever wants to be first must be your slave--<sup>28</sup>just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.

**2 Corinthians 5:21**

God made Him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.

**1 John 3:1**

How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know Him.

**Ephesians 3:20-21**

**Matthew 22:37-39**

Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." <sup>38</sup>This is the first and greatest commandment. <sup>39</sup>And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'"

**Isaiah 41:10**

So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.

**Isaiah 43:1-3**

But now, this is what the Lord says--He who created you, O Jacob, He who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. <sup>2</sup>When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze. <sup>3</sup>For I am the LORD, your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior; I give Egypt for your ransom, Cush and Seba in your stead.

**John 14:6**

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

**1 Thessalonians 5:14-17**

And we urge you, brothers, warn those who are idle, encourage the timid, help the weak, be patient with everyone. <sup>15</sup>Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always try to be kind to each other and to everyone else. <sup>16</sup>Be joyful always; <sup>17</sup>pray continually...

**1 Thessalonians 5:18-22**

Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. <sup>19</sup>Do not put out the Spirit's fire; <sup>20</sup>do not treat prophecies with contempt. <sup>21</sup>Test everything. Hold on to the good. <sup>22</sup>Avoid every kind of evil.

**Proverbs 3:9-10**

Honor the LORD with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops; <sup>10</sup>then your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine.

**Proverbs 3:11-12**

My son, do not despise the LORD's discipline and do not resent His rebuke, <sup>12</sup>because the LORD disciplines those He loves, as a father the son he delights in.

**John 10:27-30**

"My sheep listen to My voice; I know them, and they follow Me. <sup>28</sup>I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of My hand. <sup>29</sup>My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of My Father's hand. <sup>30</sup>I and the Father are one."

Peter and the other apostles replied: "We must obey God rather than men!"

**Psalms 100:1-3**

Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth. <sup>2</sup>Worship the LORD with gladness; come before Him with joyful songs. <sup>3</sup>Know that the LORD is God. It is He who made us, and we are His; we are His people, the sheep of His pasture.

**Year Four - 41 verses (page 4)**

**Psalm 100:4-5**

Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise; give thanks to Him and praise His name. <sup>5</sup>For the Lord is good and His love endures forever; His faithfulness continues through all generations.

**Ephesians 2:1-3**

As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, <sup>2</sup>in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient. <sup>3</sup>All of us also lived among them at one time, gratifying the cravings of our sinful nature and following its desires and thoughts. Like the rest, we were by nature objects of wrath.

**Ephesians 2:4-5**

But because of His great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, <sup>5</sup>made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions--it is by grace you have been saved.

**Ephesians 2:6-7**

And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, <sup>7</sup>in order that in the coming ages He might show the incomparable riches of His grace, expressed in His kindness to us in Christ Jesus.

**Ephesians 2:8-10**

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith--and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God--<sup>9</sup>not by works, so that no one can boast. <sup>10</sup>For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

**Romans 5:8**

But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

**Romans 5:9-10**

Since we have now been justified by His blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through Him! <sup>10</sup>For if, when we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to Him through the death of His Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through His life!
