

Opportunities for Ministry to Penn Manor SD:

The Loft Community Partnership, which serves families in need in the Penn Manor School District, has shared some of their current needs during this challenging time.

Operating out of the Millersville Brethren in Christ Church located at 3116 Blue Rock Road, Lancaster (17603), they are currently in the process of becoming a 501c3 organization. If you would like to contribute financially, they are accepting checks (payable to Millersville BIC with The Loft in the memo line).

Ordinarily they were packing grocery bags for 25 families in the district, but that number has grown to 150 each week during the pandemic. Though they could always use donations of non-perishable items, their greatest need seems to be MILK, BREAD, and EGGS. They also have a CLOTHING BANK that has been closed during the pandemic but will need to be refreshed for when it can reopen. If you would like a family or small group project, they need the winter clothing pulled and stored, donated clothing sorted, and spring/summer clothing brought out. Finally, we are establishing MBC as a DONATION POINT for non-perishable items! If you can contribute any of the following, they can be dropped off in the shed next to the modular, which will be unlocked at all times.
