- We don't love God as we should (Deut 32:3-4; Ps 96:1-3).
- We don't love people as we should.
- We don't like being uncomfortable.
- We haven't been trained.

IV. Our Job

- The Parable of the Soils (Mark 4) teaches us that not everyone's heart is prepared to receive the seed of the gospel.
- Evangelism is a <u>process</u> that involves cultivating, sowing, watering, and harvesting.
- Our task is to take the initiative, in the power of the Holy Spirit, to help a person move one step closer in the process of coming to Christ.

V. Tips for Proclaiming Christ in a Secular Culture

• Build friendships with unbelievers

- Pray!
 - Prepare a "Ten Most Wanted" list
 - 5-5-5 (5 friends, 5 min/day for 5 weeks)
- "Raise the flag"
 - Identify yourself as a follower of Christ
 - Keep it short and sweet
- Share faith stories
 - Talk about the living reality of your faith
 - "Once I was in a similar situation and...."
- Share your testimony of salvation
- Share a gospel illustration
