

**Fighter Verse Sheet**  
**Year Six - 44 verses**

**Romans 8:28** (Sovereignty of God)

And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose.

**Romans 8:29-30** (Salvation)

For those God foreknew He also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brothers. <sup>30</sup>And those He predestined, He also called; those He called, He also justified; those He justified, He also glorified.

**Romans 8:31-32** (Battling Anxiety)

What, then, shall we say in response to this? If God is for us, who can be against us? <sup>32</sup>He who did not spare His own Son, but gave Him up for us all—how will He not also, along with Him, graciously give us all things?

**Romans 8:33-34** (Security in God)

Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies. <sup>34</sup>Who is he that condemns? Christ Jesus, who died—more than that, who was raised to life—is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us.

**Romans 8:35-37**

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? <sup>36</sup>As it is written: “For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered.” <sup>37</sup>No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.

**Romans 8:38-39** (Security in God)

For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, <sup>39</sup>neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**1 Timothy 1:15** (Gospel)

Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners—of whom I am the worst.

**Hebrews 13:5-6** (Contentment)

Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, “Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.” <sup>6</sup>So we say with confidence, “The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?”

**Lamentations 3:21-23** (Love of God)

Yet this I call to mind and therefore I have hope: <sup>22</sup>Because of the LORD’s great love we are not consumed, for His compassions never fail. <sup>23</sup>They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.

**Lamentations 3:24-26** (Waiting on God)

I say to myself, “The LORD is my portion; therefore I will wait for Him.” <sup>25</sup>The LORD is good to those whose hope is in Him, to the one who seeks Him; <sup>26</sup>it is good to wait quietly for the salvation of the LORD.

**Lamentations 3:31-33** (Love of God)

For men are not cast off by the LORD forever. <sup>32</sup>Though He brings grief, He will show compassion, so great is His unfailing love. <sup>33</sup>For He does not willingly bring affliction or grief to the children of men.

**Year Six - 44 verses (page 2)**

**Colossians 3:16-17** (Word of the Lord)

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God. <sup>17</sup>And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

**Isaiah 26:3-4** (Trusting God)

You will keep in perfect peace him whose mind is steadfast, because he trusts in You. <sup>4</sup>Trust in the LORD forever, for the LORD, the LORD, is the Rock eternal.

**Psalm 19:7-8** (Word of the Lord)

The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul. The statutes of the LORD are trustworthy, making wise the simple. <sup>8</sup>The precepts of the LORD are right, giving joy to the heart. The commands of the LORD are radiant, giving light to the eyes.

**Psalm 19:9-11** (Word of the Lord)

The fear of the LORD is pure, enduring forever. The ordinances of the LORD are sure and altogether righteous. <sup>10</sup>They are more precious than gold, than much pure gold; they are sweeter than honey, than honey from the comb. <sup>11</sup>By them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward.

**John 6:35** (Life in Christ)

Then Jesus declared, "I am the Bread of Life. He who comes to Me will never go hungry, and He who believes in Me will never be thirsty."

**Galatians 6:9-10** (Life in Christ)

Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. <sup>10</sup>Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.

**Psalm 34:1-3** (Praise and worship)

I will extol the LORD at all times; His praise will always be on my lips. <sup>2</sup>My soul will boast in the LORD; let the afflicted hear and rejoice. <sup>3</sup>Glorify the LORD with me; let us exalt His name together.

**Psalm 34:4-5** (Seeking God)

I sought the LORD, and He answered me; He delivered me from all my fears. <sup>5</sup>Those who look to Him are radiant; their faces are never covered with shame.

**Psalm 34:6-8** (Goodness of God)

This poor man called, and the LORD called him; He saved him out of all his troubles. <sup>7</sup>The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear Him, and He delivers them. <sup>8</sup>Taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the man who takes refuge in Him.

**Psalm 34:9-11** (Provision of God)

Fear the LORD, you His saints, for those who fear Him lack nothing. <sup>10</sup>The lions may grow weak and hungry, but those who seek the LORD lack no good thing. <sup>11</sup>Come, My children, listen to Me; I will teach you the fear of the LORD.

**Psalm 34:12-14** (Speech)

Whoever of you loves life and desires to see many good days, <sup>13</sup>keep your tongue from evil and your lips from speaking lies. <sup>14</sup>Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it.

**Year Six - 44 verses (page 3)**

**Psalm 34:15-16** (Faithfulness of God)

The eyes of the LORD are on the righteous and His ears are attentive to their cry; <sup>16</sup>the face of the LORD is against those who do evil, to cut off the memory of them from the earth.

**Psalm 34:17-18** (Faithfulness of God)

The righteous cry out, and the LORD hears them; He delivers them from all their troubles. <sup>18</sup>The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.

**Psalm 34:19-22** (Suffering)

A righteous man may have many troubles, but the LORD delivers him from them all; <sup>20</sup>He protects all his bones, not one of them will be broken. <sup>21</sup>Evil will slay the wicked; the foes of the righteous will be condemned. <sup>22</sup>The LORD redeems His servants; no one will be condemned who takes refuge in Him.

**Colossians 4:6** (Speech)

Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.

**John 8:31-32** (Word of the Lord)

To the Jews who had believed Him, Jesus said, "If you hold to My teaching, you are really My disciples. <sup>32</sup>Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

**John 10:10** (Life in Christ)

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

**Jeremiah 32:40** (Goodness of God)

I will make an everlasting covenant with them; I will never stop doing good to them, and I will inspire them to fear Me, so that they will never turn away from Me.

**Psalm 73:25-26** (Trusting God)

Whom have I in heaven but You? And earth has nothing I desire besides You. <sup>26</sup>My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

**Proverbs 4:23-24** (Sanctification)

Above all else, guard your heart, for it is the wellspring of life. <sup>24</sup>Put away perversity from your mouth; keep corrupt talk far from your lips.

**Proverbs 4:25-27** (Sanctification)

Let your eyes look straight ahead, fix your gaze directly before you. <sup>26</sup>Make level paths for your feet and take only ways that are firm. <sup>27</sup>Do not swerve to the right or the left; keep your foot from evil.

**James 1:19-20** (Battling Anger)

My dear brothers, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, <sup>20</sup>for man's anger does not bring about the righteous life that God desires.

**2 Corinthians 8:9** (Humility of Christ)

For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, so that you through His poverty might become rich.

**Psalm 77:13-14** (Sovereignty of God)

Your ways, O God, are holy. What god is so great as our God? <sup>14</sup>You are the God who performs miracles; You display Your power among the peoples.

**Psalm 118:5-8** (Battling Fear)

In my anguish I cried to the LORD, and He answered by setting me free. <sup>6</sup>The LORD is with me; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me? <sup>7</sup>The LORD is with me; He is my helper. I will look in triumph on my enemies. <sup>8</sup>It is better to take refuge in the LORD than to trust in man.

**1 Timothy 6:6-7** (Contentment)

But godliness with contentment is great gain. <sup>7</sup>For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it.

**Psalm 79:9** (Salvation)

Help us, O God our Savior, for the glory of Your name; deliver us and forgive our sins for Your name's sake.

**Psalm 84:10-11** (Goodness of God)

Better is one day in Your courts than a thousand elsewhere; I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked.

**1 John 4:4** (Battling Anxiety)

You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the One who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.

**1 Corinthians 15:51-52** (Eternity)

Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed—<sup>52</sup>in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.

**Revelation 21:3** (Eternity)

And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, “Now the dwelling of God is with men, and He will live with them. They will be His people, and God Himself will be with them and be their God.”

**Revelation 21:4** (Eternity)

“He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.”

**Revelation 21:5-6** (Eternity)

He who was seated on the throne said, “I am making everything new!” Then He said, “Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true.” <sup>6</sup>He said to me, “It is done.
