## Follow-Ups



Follow-up is an important aspect of LCMI's discipleship process. We do not run camps unless we are doing so in partnership with a local church, so that the campers are able to be connected to a church for ongoing discipleship after the LCMI camp is over. Follow-up visits are a time when our missionaries on the ground visit the campers who have attended our camps that year and/or the previous year and check up on them. A follow-up visit usually consists of sharing of a devotion from God's word, singing songs from camp, taking prayer requests, praying together and enjoy a snack together while catching up..
