Principle | Passover

PASSOVER	OLD TESTAMENT PASSOVER	NEW TESTAMENT PASSOVER
1 Instruction to Sacrifice	"Take ... a lamb ... [and] ... kill it" (Exodus 12:3,6)	"Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world" (John 1:29).
2 Condition of Sacrifice	"Your lamb shall be without blemish" (Exodus 12:5)	"... the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot" (1 Peter 1:19).
3 Reason for Sacrifice	"I will execute judgment" (Exodus 12:12)	"It is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment" (Hebrews 9:27).
4 Application of Sacrifice	"Every man shall take for himself a lamb" (Exodus 12:3)	"Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved" (Acts 4:12).
5 Result of Sacrifice	"The Lamb will pass over the door and not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike you" (Exodus 12:23)	"There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus" (Romans 8:1).

"For indeed Christ, our Passover (Lamb), was sacrificed for us" (1 Corinthians 5:7).
