Year One - 44 verses

Deuteronomy 7:9

Know therefore that the LORD your God is God: He is the faithful God, keeping His covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love Him and keep His commands.

Deuteronomy 10:12-13

And now, I Israel, what does the LORD your God ask of you but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways, to Love Him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul,
¹³and to observe the LORD'S commands and decrees that I am giving you today for your own good?

John 1:12-13

Yet to all who received Him, to those who believed in His name, He gave the right to become children of God--¹³children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

Romans 11:33-34

Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable His judgments, and His paths beyond tracing out!³⁴Who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has been His counselor?

Romans 11:35-36

³⁵Who has ever given to God, that God should repay him?³⁶For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. To Him be the glory forever! Amen.

Romans 12:1-2

Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God--this is your spiritual act of worship.²Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is--His good, pleasing and perfect will.

Psalm 56:3-4

When I am afraid, I will trust in You.⁴In God, whose word I praise, in God I trust; I will not be afraid. What can mortal man do to me?

Psalm 62:5-7

Find rest, O my soul, in God alone; my hope comes from Him.⁶He alone is my rock and my salvation; He is my fortress, I will not be shaken.⁷My salvation and my honor depend on God; He is my mighty rock, my refuge.

Romans 8:1

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus...

1 John 2:15-17

Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.¹⁶For everything in the world--the cravings of sinful man, the lust of his eyes and the boasting of what he has and does--comes not from the Father but from the world.¹⁷The world and its desires pass away, but the man who does the will of God lives forever.

Philippians 2:5-7

Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus:⁶Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped,⁷but made Himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

Philippians 2:8-9

And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to death--even death on a cross! ⁹Therefore God exalted Him to the highest place and gave Him the name that is above every name,

Philippians 2:10-11

..that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,
¹¹and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Philippians 2:12-13

Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed--not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence--continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, ¹³for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to His good purpose.

James 1:2-3

Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, ³because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance.

James 1:4-5

Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.
⁵If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him.

Psalm 1:1-2

Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers. ²But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on His law he meditates day and night.

Psalm 1:3-4

He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers. ⁴Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away.

Psalm 1:5-6

Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.
⁶For the LORD watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.

Colossians 3:1-3

Since then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. ²Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. ³For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God.

Ephesians 4:26

In your anger do not sin. Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry...

Isaiah 40:28-29

Do you not know? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and His understanding no one can fathom. ²⁹He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.

Isaiah 40:30-31

Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall: ³¹but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

Psalm 86:5-7

You are forgiving and good, O Lord, abounding in love to all who call to You. ⁶Hear my prayer, O LORD; listen to my cry for mercy. ⁷In the day of my trouble I will call to You, for You will answer me.

1 Timothy 2:5

For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus...

1 Peter 1:3-5

Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In His great mercy He has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, ⁴and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade--kept in heaven for you, ⁵who through faith are shielded by God's power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time.

Ephesians 6:10-11

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His might power. ¹¹Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.

Ephesians 6:12-13

For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

¹³Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.

Ephesians 6:14-15

Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, ¹⁵and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.

Ephesians 6:16-17

In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. ¹⁷Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

Philippians 1:6

...being confident of this, that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

Matthew 10:28

Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, be afraid of the One who can destroy both soul and body in hell.

Romans 1:16

I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile.

Matthew 11:28-30

"Come to Me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. ²⁹Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. ³⁰For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

Psalm 20:6-7

Now I know that the LORD saves His anointed; He answers him from His holy heaven with the saving power of His right hand. ⁷Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God.

James 1:12

Blessed is the man who perseveres under trial, because when he has stood the test, he will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love Him.

2 Corinthians 9:6-7

Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. ⁷Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

2 Corinthians 9:8

And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.

2 Corinthians 12:9

But He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.

Isaiah 64:4

Since ancient times no one has heard, no ear has perceived, no eye has seen any God besides You, who acts on behalf of those who wait for Him.

Titus 3:4-6

But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, ⁵He saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of His mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, ⁶whom He poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior...

Isaiah 46:9-10

Remember the former things, those of long ago; I am God, and there is no other; I am God and there is none like Me. ¹⁰I make known the end from the beginning, from ancient times, what is still to come. I say: My purpose will stand, and I will do all that I please.

Proverbs 1:10

My son, if sinners entice you, do not give in to them.

Proverbs 3:5-6
