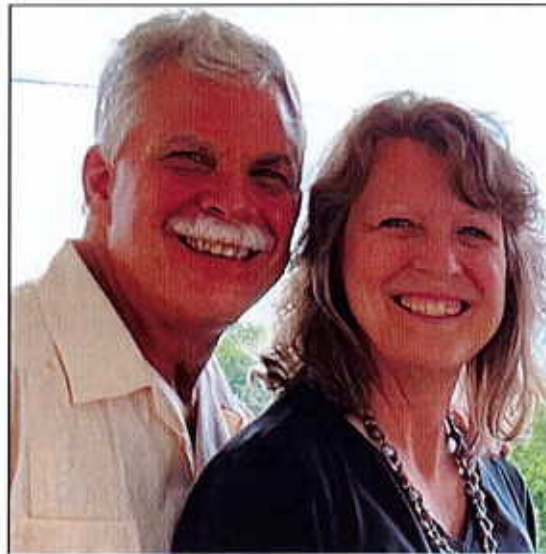

It's great to be back in touch! In switching back and forth between countries and telephone numbers, we were locked out of our account. Praise the Lord! - we were just now able to resolve the problem!

September

We landed back in Germany August 30th, and started settling back in right away. The first week back, we attended a week-long biblical counseling seminar with Jim and Caroline Newheiser. The themes discussed were heavy but important topics for being able to help others in need.

We got back into the routine of meetings and appointments. Daniel attended a

retreat with the Cornerstone leadership, which was a blessing to all. Debbie has started to attend the ladies' biblical counseling class that meets once a month, and that has been a blessing as well.

Daniel is still battling ear pain, going to the ENT here by us. Because of that, he has not been well enough to travel back into Ukraine. We were, however, able to organize \$5,000 from BMW to go to winter clothing and shoes for the folks there! Praise the Lord for His provision!

October

One very exciting development this month is the "reboot "of the hearing impaired Bible study! When we left Berlin in January 2009, the hearing impaired church was in the very capable hands of Thomas, a deaf man who attended the EBTC (Daniel translated for him). His wife became sick and they had to move to a different city for medical care, so the church dwindled to a Bible study. Our coworker Chris has been faithfully ministering to hearing impaired, but it has been tough. The church leaders of Cornerstone are excited to provide their facilities for the Bible study to be held, and we hope to see growth of participants and involvement. They meet every other Monday evening.

Something else that Daniel was able to do was to join a friend and ministry partner on a trip to Istanbul. It is such a huge city, and it was so very impactful to see the needs and opportunities there. It was also a huge blessing to see someone he had met years ago in a different context- a very joyful reunion!

Debbie was able to turn in the first half of her biblical counseling exam, and has started working on her second half. She is challenged and blessed to go through this process, which has been a spiritual encouragement to her as well. She was also able to take part in an annual German biblical counseling conference via livestream on the biblical view of emotions.
