Some of you may not have heard so I thought I would write this quick update to let you all know together so that you all may be praying. This Christmas looked a little different for us. On Friday night before Christmas John was decorating the hall for our Christmas Eve service and had a major heart attack. We are so thankful to the speed in which everyone acted. By God's providence John was next door to South Doc and the Cardiac Ambulance was 4 minutes away. Within 20 minutes John was rushed to Limerick Hospital where they put a stent in to clear the blockage. We are so thankful for how the pieces fell in together. John is doing well. He is up walking and managing well. He is still in Limerick hospital awaiting a bed in Tralee General to open up. He will then meet the team at the General for aftercare and what we all do going forward. Tests will need to be done to find out the cause of the heart attack. So we have lots of changes ahead of us in 2023 but not all bad.

- a bed to open up soon in Tralee
- for his recovery
- adapting to new changes in lifestyle (for the family also)

God has been so good to us. This year has been a year of trials but we have learned so much and God continues to teach us very valuable lessons. Pain is not without purpose.
