As for man, his days are like grass, he flourishes like a flower of the field; ¹⁶the wind blows over it and it is gone, and its place remembers it no more.

Psalms 103:17-19

But from everlasting to everlasting the LORD'S love is with those who fear Him, and His righteousness with their children's children--¹⁸with those who keep His covenant and remember to obey His precepts. ¹⁹The LORD has established His throne in heaven, and His kingdom rules over all.

Ephesians 4:31-32

³²Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Deuteronomy 6:4-5

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. ⁵Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.

1 Peter 5:6-8

Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that He may lift you up in due time. ⁷Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you. ⁸Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

1 Peter 5:9-10

Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that your brothers throughout the world are undergoing the same kind of sufferings. ¹⁰And the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will Himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.

Proverbs 18:10
