### TWO GROUPS OF PEOPLE:

1. The \_\_\_\_\_ unbeliever (1:18-32). Knows \_\_\_\_\_, but doesn’t \_\_\_\_\_.
2. The \_\_\_\_\_ unbeliever (2:1-6). Knows \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_ others.

Note: Both groups are without \_\_\_\_\_ (1:20; 2:1).

### THREE MARKS OF A TRUE CHRISTIAN:

- I. DOES NOT \_\_\_\_\_ OR \_\_\_\_\_ OF SINFUL BEHAVIOR (Romans 1:18-32).
- II. DOES NOT SIT IN \_\_\_\_\_ OF \_\_\_\_\_ (Romans 2:1-6).

### IMPORTANT PRINCIPLES TO LIVE BY:

- ◆ I will not show \_\_\_\_\_ for the riches of God’s kindness that led me to \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 4).
- ◆ I will not \_\_\_\_\_ my own \_\_\_\_\_ (2:1-3; Exodus 20; Matthew 5).

- ◆ I will seek to demonstrate \_\_\_\_\_, not \_\_\_\_\_ (2:1-3; Mt. 9:36; 23:37; 2 Pet. 3:9).
- ◆ I will pray for unbeliever’s spiritual \_\_\_\_\_ to be \_\_\_\_\_ (2 Tim. 2:24-26; 2 Cor. 4:3-4).
- ◆ I will avoid confusing \_\_\_\_\_ unbelievers with the proper \_\_\_\_\_ of believers in the church (Mt. 7:1-5; 18:15-20; 1 Cor. 5:9-13).

### III. \_\_\_\_\_ IN A LIFE THAT BEARS FRUIT IN KEEPING WITH \_\_\_\_\_ (Romans 2:7-11).

### IMPORTANT PRINCIPLES CONTINUED:

- ◆ Know I am not \_\_\_\_\_ by my works, but also know that without works my \_\_\_\_\_ is not real (2:5-11; John 5:24-29; 2 Cor. 5:10; 1 Pet. 4:17-18).
- ◆ Regular \_\_\_\_\_ demonstrates I see sin as God sees it. It’s not for the believer’s salvation, but allows for continued intimate fellowship with Him (1 John. 1:6-9).
