### Anexpected Blessings of Having "God with Us":

- Blessing = a special <u>favor</u>, mercy, or <u>benefit</u>.
- Jesus <u>sympathizes</u> with us in our weaknesses. He knows what it is to be <u>tempted</u> in all <u>points</u> as we are. (Heb. 4:14-16; Mt. 11:28-30).
- 2. Jesus knows what it means to be <u>mistreated</u> (John 8:41).
- 3. We should expect <u>persecution</u> (Jn. 15:18-25; Mt. 5:10-12).
- 4. Jesus <u>feels</u> real <u>emotion</u> about us (Jn. 11:17-44; Lk 13:34-35).

- 5. Jesus showed us that His top priority was the <u>gospel</u> (Lk. 19:1-10; Mt. 26:26-29).
- 6. The guarantee that since Jesus was <u>resurrected</u>, we, too, will be <u>resurrected</u> (Rom. 6:5; 1 Cor. 15:20-22).
