An ESL volunteer brought **Bush** and **Carrie** to Global Connect because of their exposure to the Bible in ESL and their interest in learning more. They're hungry. They lamented how the Chinese government kept this kind of information from them. After a couple months in Global Connect they shared how they each had an "aha" moment that there really is a God and the Bible is true. They are believers in what they understand so far. Please pray that they would also come to truly understand and embrace the gospel. They are so close.



Two more Chinese people who are close are Cindy and "Julie". They are both in ESL, both in Jo Ann's Bible study and Cindy also comes

to Global Connect. Julie is also very close to trusting Christ. She shared with Jo Ann "Life has left me empty. I want to know how to have a relationship with God."

N. and **P.** are from Iran and attend ESL. They are now regularly attending another church where the gospel is being preached. They, too, are very close to faith. The church in Iran is said to be the fastest growing church in the world.
