#### The Law Defined

Ceremonial - fulfilled in Christ

Judicial - set aside

Moral - **fulfilled** in Christ (10 Commandments)

#### Romans 7:7-12

"Is the Law the cause of sinful behavior?"

Answer: Absolutely Not!

## The Purpose of the Law

### **Reveal** sin

"Yet if it had not been for the law, I would not have known sin. For I would not have known what it is to covet if the law had not said, 'You shall not covet.'" Romans 7:7
