

The missionary report of Igor Yusenkov for the 1st quarter of 2024

I greet you in the glorious name of Jesus Christ!

Thank you brothers and sisters of the SGA mission, for your regular and timely help, and your prayers for my ministry.

I continue to serve in charge of the chaplaincy department of the region. Many different events and changes have taken place in the recent period. The war is becoming more and more brutal and people are losing hope for its end. This also affects the state of the military. They need more and more spiritual support and words of hope. Therefore, there is a need to constantly serve our soldiers and their families.

During this time, other ministers who are already working in this direction have joined our team of military chaplaincy.

We regularly visit various units, serve soldiers on the front lines, and go to war zones. We also serve the families of the victims, and a team of nurses regularly visit wounded soldiers in the hospital. In April, we plan to hold a Sunday camp for the wives of fallen soldiers.

There is a bathhouse on wheels that we use for military personnel in the war zone.

We periodically meet as a team for joint prayer and discussion, for improving military service.

All planned Christmas events were held in the divisions. We had about 400 sweet gifts that were presented to military children. I organized the teams, music groups, transportation and necessary assistance with which we visited units.

I have a very good relationship with the commanders through whom we have the opportunity to serve our defenders. Also, whenever possible, I organize visits to our military churches. This inspires them a lot and restores their strength. I conduct personal conversations where we read God's Word and pray. The fighters accept Christ and ask for the Gospel. Sometimes the commanders ask for help, they also need recovery of strength, advice and prayer.

There is a need to purchase an inexpensive cargo minibus for our team. Please support me with prayer in this matter.

My family also serves the Lord. I have four children and three grandchildren. Three are members of the church. The younger daughter is 11 years old. Please pray for my family as well, for my church and my chaplaincy.
