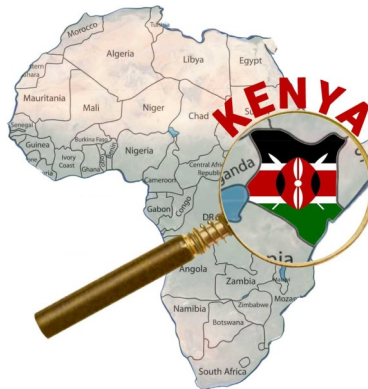


## Summer Update

There will be an intensive training time over the next few weeks for Kenyan college students to study God's word, grow in spiritual disciplines, and fellowship with other believers. Our students will be joining them for this time and helping to lead Bible studies, workshops, and participate in the training as a whole. This is a unique opportunity for our students to not only grow in their walk with God, but to learn how to help others grow, and even better, other nations!

The team left the United States on Sunday, June 30th and has safely arrived in Nairobi. They plan to return at the beginning of August.
