### **Psalm 8:1 (Lesson 1)**

O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens.

### **Psalm 20:7 (Lesson 2)**

Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God.

### **Proverbs 18:10 (Lesson 2)**

The name of the LORD is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.

### **Jeremiah 32:17 (Lesson 3)**

“Ah, Sovereign LORD, you have made the heavens and earth by your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for you.”

### **Isaiah 40:28 (Lesson 3)**

Do you not know? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom.

### **Acts 17:24-25 (Lesson 4)**

The God who made the world and everything in it is the Lord of heaven and earth and does not live in temples built by hands. And he is not served by human hands, as if he needed anything, because he himself gives all men life and breath and everything else.

### **Romans 11:34-36 (Lesson 4)&(Lesson 29)**

“Who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has been his counselor?” “Who has ever given to God, that God should repay him?” For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be the glory forever! Amen.

### **Job 42:2 (Lesson 5)**

“I know that you can do all things; no plan of yours can be thwarted.”

### **Luke 6:46 (Lesson 6)**

### **Matthew 6:33 (Lesson 7)**

### **2 Chronicles 16:9a (Lesson 8)**

For the eyes of the LORD range throughout the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him.”

### **Proverbs 15:3 (Lesson 8)**

The eyes of the LORD are everywhere, keeping watch on the wicked and the good.

### **Psalm 103:2-3 (Lesson 9)**

Praise the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits. He forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases...

**Psalm 34:7 (Lesson 10)**

The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear him, and he delivers them.

**Psalm 89:8 (Lesson 10)**

O LORD God Almighty, who is like you? You are mighty, O LORD, and your faithfulness surrounds you.

**Psalm 20:6 (Lesson 11)**

Now I know that the LORD saves his anointed; he answers him from his holy heaven with the saving power of his right hand.

**I John 4:4b (Lesson 11)**

...the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.

**Isaiah 26:3 (Lesson 12)**

You will keep in perfect peace him whose mind is steadfast, because he trusts in you.

**Psalm 100:3 (Lesson 13)**

Know that the LORD is God. It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture.

**Joshua 1:9 (Lesson 14)**

“Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be terrified; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go.”

**Psalm 18:30 (Lesson 15)**

As for God, his way is perfect; the word of the LORD is flawless. He is a shield for all who take refuge in him.

**Numbers 23:19 (Lesson 15)**

“God is not a man, that he should lie, nor a son of man, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill?”

**Psalm 56:3-4 (Lesson 16)**

When I am afraid, I will trust in you. In God, whose word I praise, in God I trust; I will not be afraid. What can mortal man do to me?

**Psalm 27:1 (Lesson 17)**

The LORD is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid?

**Psalm 47:2 (Lesson 18)**

How awesome is the LORD Most High, the great King over all the earth!

**Daniel 2:20-21 (Lesson 18)**

“Praise be to the name of God for ever and ever; wisdom and power are his. He changes times and seasons; he sets up kings and deposes them. He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to the discerning.

**John 1:12 (Lesson 21)**

Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God...

**John 1:1 (Lesson 22)**

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

**I Peter 3:18 (Lesson 23)**

For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was put to death in the body but made alive by the Spirit...

**I John 2:1b (Lesson 24)**

But if anybody does sin, we have one who speaks to the Father in our defense—Jesus Christ, the Righteous One.

**I Timothy 2:5 (Lesson 24)**

For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus...

**I Peter 2:6 (Lesson 25)**

For in Scripture it says: "See I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who trusts in him will never be put to shame."

**I John 5:4-5 (Lesson 26)**

...for everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. Who is it that overcomes the world? Only he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God.

**Daniel 4:35 (Lesson 27)**

All the peoples of the earth are regarded as nothing. He does as he pleases with the powers of heaven and the peoples of the earth. No one can hold back his hand or say to him: "What have you done?"

**Romans 8:1 (Lesson 28)**

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus...

**Jeremiah 29:13 (Lesson 30)**

You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.

**Exodus 34:14 (Lesson 31)**

Do not worship any other god, for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God.

**Matthew 6:24 (Lesson 31)**

**Exodus 20:7 (Lesson 35)**

"You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God, for the LORD will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name."

**James 1:2-3 (Lesson 36)**

Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance.

**James 1:12 (Lesson 36)**

Blessed is the man who perseveres under trial, because when he has stood the test, he will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him.

**Isaiah 46:9 (Lesson 37)**

"Remember the former things, those of long ago; I am God, and there is no other; I am God and there is none like me."
