1. Deliverance from Egypt (v. 5; Numbers 13-14).

Judgment: Destroyed in the desert.

MAIN PROBLEM WOVEN THROUGHOUT ALL THESE EXAMPLES:

- ★ Unbelief, which is an attack on God’s character. It is treating God with contempt (v. 5; Numbers 14:23).
2. Angels abandoned proper dwelling (v. 6; 2 Peter 2:4; Genesis 6:1-4).
Judgment: Chained in darkness until Judgment Day.
3. Sexual immorality and perversion in Sodom and Gomorrah (v. 7; Genesis 19; 2 Peter 2).

Judgment: Suffer the punishment of eternal fire.

3 SPECIFIC SINS OF FALSE TEACHERS:

*Note: All ungodly people claiming to be believers are false teachers.

1. Pollute their own bodies (v. 8).
2. Reject authority (v. 8).
3. Blaspheme the glorious ones (v. 8).

BOTTOM LINE: These people demonstrate they are not Christians by slandering or ignoring what Scripture calls sin, doing, instead, what is right in their own eyes (v. 10; 2 Peter 2:12).

THE ANTIDOTE TO FALSE TEACHING:

- ★ Believing/Trusting God that He will do everything He said He would do.
- ★ Continually feed on and obey the Word of God (Matthew 4:4; Luke 11:28; 1 John 2:5).

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:
