#### 3 SPECIFIC SINS OF FALSE TEACHERS:

*Note: All ungodly people claiming to be believers are fals	e
teachers.	

- 1. Pollute their own bodies (v. 8).
- 2. Reject <u>authority</u> (v. 8).
- 3. Blaspheme the glorious ones (v. 8).

BOTTOM LINE: These people demonstrate they are not Christians by slandering or ignoring what Scripture calls sin, doing, instead, what is right in their own eyes (v. 10; 2 Peter 2:12).

#### THE ANTIDOTE TO FALSE TEACHING:

- ★ <u>Believing/Trusting</u> God that He will do <u>everything</u> He said He would do.
- ★ Continually <u>feed</u> on and <u>obey</u> the Word of God (Matthew 4:4; Luke 11:28; 1 John 2:5).
