### THREE WAYS TO IDENTIFY TRAITORS/ APOSTATES IN THE CHURCH:

*	Note: The most dangerous <u>traitor</u> is the one
	who doesn't even know he's doing the enemy's work.
1.	Is <u>ungodly</u> (v. 4). The Greek word used here in Jude means "destitute of reverential awe toward God."
2.	Perverts the grace of God into a license
	forimmorality_ (v. 4; antidote Titus 2:11-14).
*	This is the Antinomian heresy.
	"Once the supreme authority of God's Word is diminished, apostasy is soon to follow."
3.	<b>Denies</b> Jesus Christ our only Sovereign and Lord.
	The 4 things being denied about Jesus in this verse:
	1. His universal <u>sovereignty</u> .
	<ol> <li>His position as <u>Lord</u> of the <u>believer's</u> life.</li> </ol>
	3. His role as <u>Savior</u> .
	4. His role as <u>Messiah</u> .
